Participants between the ages of 13 and 18 are instructed in the essential techniques of filmmaking, ably lead by guest professionals in the field. The studio will be based out of Meaford Hall from August 9 to 20.

The first studio last year resulted in three exceptional films designed, directed, edited produced and starring the young participants and their instructors. These films opened each evening of the Meaford International Film Festival on Labour Day weekend, and this year promises the same opportunity for our budding filmmakers.
